The scramble has a shotgun start from the white tees. All teams are generated by the computer, and each team will have at least one "A" player. The tournament has a \$5 entry fee, the dinner is supplied by the Men's Club.

The second event is the 4-Man Two Best Ball on April 25. This tournament is a tee time start on the Blue Tees. Get a team together and sign-up after the course re-opens. If you can't find a team, or need an extra golfer or two for your team, Ryan will do his best to find you a team or team mates.

New Coronavirus Precautions

In order to minimize contact with common surfaces, the course has modified the cups on the greens. The cups have Insulation foam in them, surrounding the flagstick. If your ball hits the foam, it is considered in the hole. This eliminates the need to reach into the cup to retrieve a ball. The flagsticks are to remain in the holes. This eliminates the need to touch the flagstick.

It is also recommended that you not pick up stray balls or tees on the golf course. You literally do not know where they have been.

If you rent a cart, it is a good idea to bring some disinfectant wipes to go over the surfaces like the key, the steering wheel and the seats.

Finally, if you are concerned about face-to-face contact, or handling money at the course, you can call in your credit or debit card number to the Pro Shop. The desk personnel request that you wait until you are safely parked in the parking lot before you call in your number.

If you rent a cart, the Pro Shop folks can hand the key to you out the side window of the shop so you don't need to go inside.

Here's hoping that we can get back to golf, soon.
