# Two events, One Old, One New

This month we have the ever-popular Screwdriver Open, and we have added the first-ever Two Cup Tournament.

The Screwdriver Open is a four-man scramble format, played from the Blue Tees. It is an Open tournament, and that means that your team members need not be in the Men's Club. This event is put on by Madrona Links itself, not the Men's Club, hence the Open format. In the past the Screw-driver has lived up to its name due to the free Screwdrivers (and Bloody Marys) available before tee time. This year, due to the closure of restaurants by the Covid protocols, the drinks are not expected to be available. Nor is the usual breakfast and Lunch that came as part of the entry fee. As a result, the entry fee is greatly reduced. Entry cost is \$60 per person. The fee covers the prize fund and a Cash Skins Game.

Unlike previous Screwdrivers, this will be a tee-time event, so sign up early. Get your team together and fill out an entry form. Forms are available at the Pro Shop Desk or online at the Madrona Links website (www.madronalinks.com).

Later in the month we have the Men's Club-sponsored Two Cup Tournament. This promises to be an interesting and somewhat unpredictable event. It will be played from the white tees, and each green will have two cups, but no flagsticks. Once you are on the green you can putt to either cup to hole out. Many of us have a hard time hitting directly at the flagstick, but we could get a break and accidentally end up close to one of the unmarked holes on the green. I have no idea if there will be prizes for KP, or how that will be handled. Because this is a Men's Club event, you must be a member in good standing to participate.
