Turkey Shoot/Poison Ball, November 12

Summer's Gone

Now that Summer has left us, the number of events per month goes down significantly. We have only one Men's Club event this month.

On November 12 the Men's Club presents the annual Turkey Shoot / Poison Ball Tournament. This event is unlike any other tournament that we have. Four-man teams will play a combination theeman scramble and a one man poison ball.

Each team will be given two numbered "poison" balls. One player will play the poison ball while the other three play a scramble. The interesting part is that it is not always the same man that plays the poison ball. The team captain must establish a rotation so that each player gets to use the poison ball several times during the round.

Why is it called a poison ball? The poison balls must be returned to the Pro Shop along with the scorecard. If only one is turned in, the team has four strokes added to their score. If no poison balls are turned in, the team is disqualified. This makes it important to choose which players will have the poison ball on the water holes, or the holes with out of bounds areas.

As if that wasn't enough, if the poison ball rotation is not followed correctly, the team will be disqualified.

The play is from the white tees, and the tournament will have a shotgun start.

As a reward for putting yourself through the poison ball anxiety, each player will be able to take home a frozen turkey.

Sign up in the Pro Shop, either as a team or as an individual. Ryan will do his best to get everyone on a team.
