Two Exciting Events This Month

How did Summer go by so quickly? Even though we are headed into Fall, we still have two events to look forward to this month.

The first is the ever-popular 3 Formats Tournament, also known as the 6-6-6. This is a two-man team event that features three different formats, each consisting of six holes. In the past it has been a mix of things like a Chapman or Scramble for six holes, followed by one best ball for six holes, and closing out with a two man total score for six holes. I haven't heard the official order of formats, but you can be sure that the last six holes will be the total score holes. They are always the true test of the team. Play will be from the white tees. As always you can sign up as a team or a single. If you need a partner the Pro Shop will do their best to find one for you.

The second event is a Madrona Links event, not a Men's Club event. It is the 7th edition of the Gig Harbor Amateur, and it is an Open Tournament played from the Blue Tees over the course of two days. The competition will be flighted, based on the number of entries and 1/3 of the field will be awarded prizes. Prizes will be awarded for both Gross and Net scores.

The total prize fund is determined by the number of entries, but there is a guaranteed prize for Overall Gross Champion and Overall Net Champion. Each will receive a \$750 prize.

The entry fee is \$150, and it covers the two tournament rounds, a practice round on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday, depending on tee time availability. Also included are a tee prize, two meals, and two drink tickets.

The entry deadline is September 23rd. Applications are available at the Pro Shop desk, or online at www.madronalinks.com.
