Turkey Shoot/Poison Ball

Fall Into Winter Golf

As the weather gets colder and days get shorter, our opportunities for golf are slimming down. We will only have one Men's Club tournament this month.

On November 11th, the Men's Club will host the annual Turkey Shoot / Poison Ball Tournament. Play will be from the white tees with a 9am shotgun start. This 4-man event is always a favorite and has a unique scramble/individual format with each team receiving two "poison" balls prenumbered by the Pro Shop. Each hole, three members of the team will play a scramble and one person will individually play the poison ball. The interesting part is that the player responsible for playing the poison ball will rotate each hole. It is the job of each team to establish the rotation order so every player gets to use the poison ball multiple holes throughout the round. Be sure to follow this rotation strictly, because if the rotation is not followed correctly, the team will be disqualified.

Why is it called a poison ball? Well, the poison balls must be returned to the Pro Shop along with your team's scorecard. If only one ball is turned in, the team will have 4 strokes added to their score. If no poison balls are turned in, the team is disqualified. No pressure.

Per usual, sign up in the Pro Shop either as an individual or as a team. And as a reward for such a nerve-racking round of golf, each player will be able to take home a frozen turkey! This will also be the last opportunity to purchase a raffle ticket for a chance to win free golf for a year.

The annual Christmas Party will be on December 8th this year. Doors open at 5pm and Prime Rib dinner will be served at 6pm. Space is limited, so please sign up in the Pro Shop. We will be drawing the winner of the annual pass raffle (no need to attend to win) and giving out lots of other prizes!
